Educational Training and Networking Events

- Global Education Lectures – Seminar events, either in-person or virtual, taught by DBU faculty, guest speakers, and the hosting school for schools in your region.

GLOBAL EDUCATION LECTURES



Global Education Lectures are seminar events taught by DBU faculty, guest speakers, and often the hosting school administration. These seminars can be in person or virtual throughout the world for Global Community partner schools. These programs are offered for the benefit of our partner teachers and staff. Additionally, many Global Community partners may wish to invite other nearby colleague institutions.

Our staff will confer with your school to create a program just for your needs. Lectures can cover a range of issues related to curriculum development, classroom mentoring, educational leadership, biblical training, and many other subjects that meet the interests and needs of your teachers and students.

Program Details

Program length: Seminar events are usually 1-3 days depending on the host school's preferences.

Cost: FREE. There is no charge for Global Lecture programs. DBU only asks for the host school to cover lodging, local transportation, and meals for the faculty leading the training.

Logistics: Global Community staff will be responsible for all program teachings and planning. Completion certificates can be offered at the end of each seminar.

Scheduling: We offer **3 seminar requests per quarter** (12 seminars in a year). Programs are scheduled based on priority of requests and availability of faculty/professors.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a high school junior or senior (last two years of high school)
- Complete the Pre-College Academy application
- Official high school transcript
- 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Copy of passport or government-issued I.D.
- Proof of English Ability (TOEFL:71; DET 90; IETLS 6.0; CAE 163)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: When is the application deadline?

A: Deadline depends on which term the students would like to start classes.

Q: Is a student automatically accepted to DBU if they have participated in the Pre-College Academy?

A: No, the student must meet all admission requirements to be accepted to DBU.

Q: How many courses can a student take?

A: There is no limit on the number of classes a student can take per term.

Q: Are textbooks included in the cost of tuition?

A: No, students are responsible for acquiring their own textbooks.

SCHOLARSHIPS INFORMATION

New incoming (freshmen) from Global Community partner schools are eligible to apply for the following scholarships:

GLOBAL COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP (\$100 / PER CREDIT HOUR)

CHRISTIAN SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP (\$4,000 PER YEAR)

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS (\$8,000 - \$14,000 PER YEAR)

CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP (UP TO \$3,000 PER YEAR)

AND OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE!

Students Must Meet And Maintain All Of The Requirements, Including (But Not Limited To):

- **Must be an active Christian**
- **Pay the semester balance remaining after scholarships before the first day of classes**
- **Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0**
- **Attend DBU under an F-1 visa as a full-time student**
- **Live on campus**
- **Complete the required service hours each semester**
- **Students are not eligible for academic scholarships or the Christian Leadership scholarship if not awarded the Christian Service Scholarship**

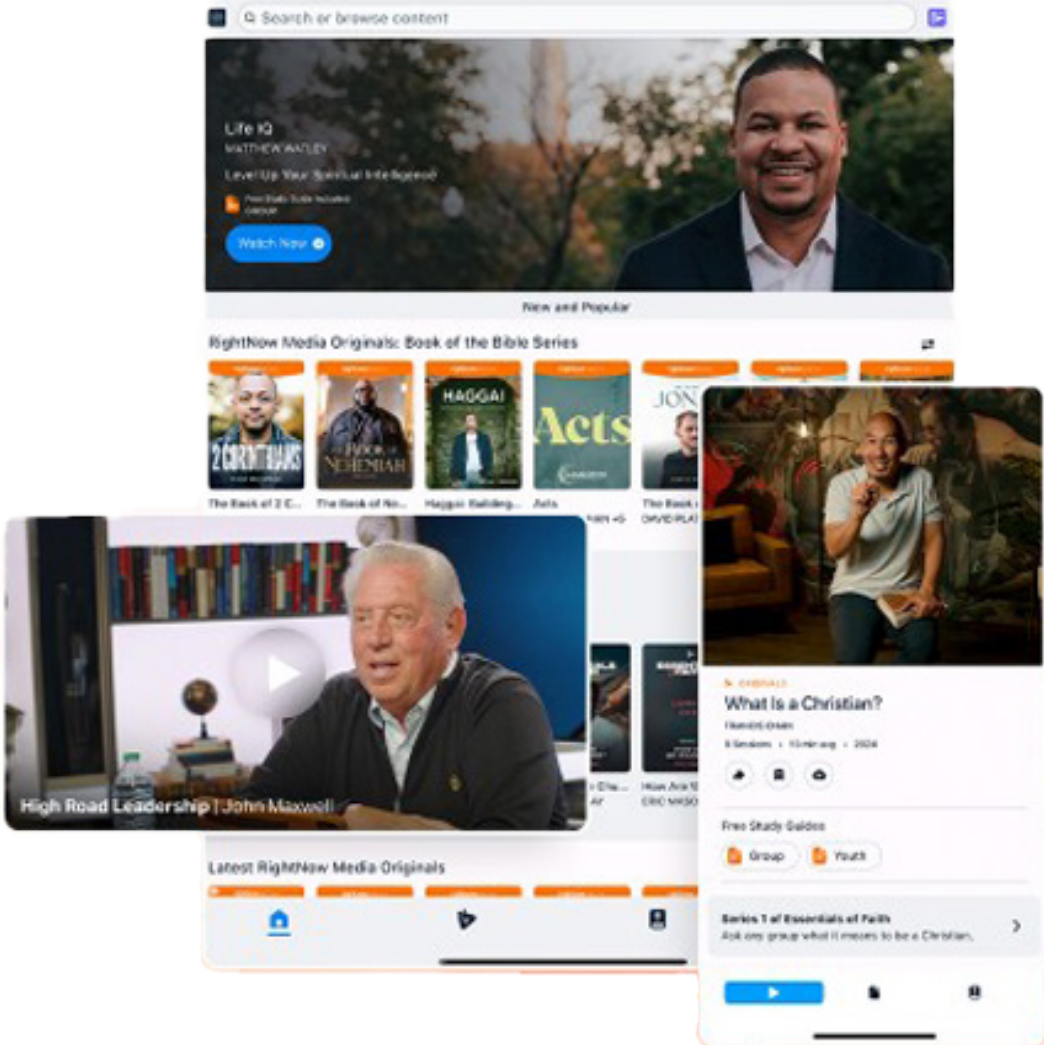
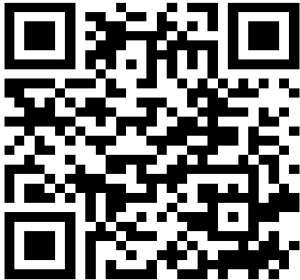
